Dear Mr O'Neill,

Please find enclosed a copy of the New Zealand War Medal application made by Patrick Dougherty (MW 2673). I have checked the capitation rolls for the Wanganui Rangers and Wanganui Yeomanry Cavalry (AD 22/85) and the land grant register (AD 31/9) without locating Mr Dougherty. Patrick Dougherty does, however, appear on the acquittance roll for members of the Wanganui Yeomanry Cavalry who served with the East Coast Expeditionary Force (AD 23/4) (copy enclosed).

The Wanganui Rangers and the 2nd Waikato regiment are not synonymous. The Waikato regiments were a permanent force of paid men who were eligible for a land grant for a specific period of service, while the Wanganui Rangers were a volunteer corps who received minimal payment and were called for service when the situation demanded.

I hope this information proves useful.
